There will be trade stands, concourse competitions for best 'New' and 'Used' Griff, organised runs out, technical talks, loads of car banter and catch up, and a 'noise off' competition! The Rolling Road will be in action all day plus all the vendors will be on hand to discuss your needs and answer any questions you may have. Saturday night will hopefully be the now traditional BBQ with live band at the White Horse (assuming the new landlord is in place). Contingency is a BBQ or hog roast at the hotel. Book early as this is always oversubscribed.
- Sunday is a quieter day – thankfully! The Rolling Road will still be running and vendors will be in attendance. A chance for a last run out or catch up with friends, old and new.
