At 557 metres, Pendle Hill dominates the surrounding Forest of Bowland, an Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty, providing spectacular views that stretch all the way to the coast on a clear day. This inspirational mound has a long and dramatic history, which dates all the way back to the Bronze Age - an ancient burial site was discovered at the summit of Pendle Hill. However, it is the sensational events that took place during the 17th century for which it is best known

**THE PLAN**, is to meet at the car park in the quaint village of Barley, from where we will travel by superior Mini bus to the nick of Pendle which is the departure point for our walk, which will take approximately 2 Hours. Our destination being the Pendle Inn back in Barley, where we can all recover over a Traditional pint or two and enjoy a traditional lunch before being re united with your transport.

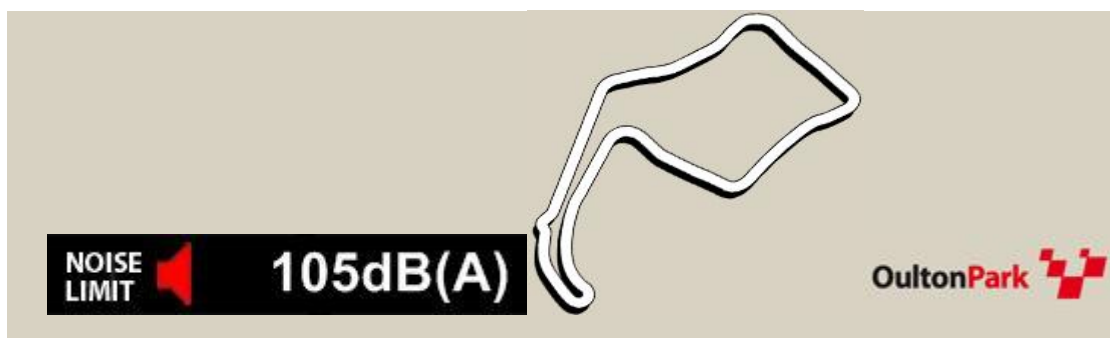
At all Novice Only days we have:

**We will be going back to Harewood Hill Climb school again on the 24<sup>th</sup> June 2010**

**Our plan as in previous years is to stay the night of the 23<sup>rd</sup> at a hotel near Harewood. The format is to relax with a few beers and be refreshed for the 0830 start on the 24<sup>th</sup>.**

The fee for the course is £160 (including VAT) and includes morning coffee, excellent buffet lunch and afternoon tea. Guest(s) may join for lunch etc at a cost of £15 per person. Cars must be silenced to road legal limits and be on road tyres, taxed and tested (where appropriate). Tax discs and test certificates will be inspected on arrival. *No tax, no test, no run.*

**Cars must have 2 seats with 2 effective seat belts**, please make sure your clothing covers your arms and legs. Remember to bring warm clothing and waterproofs.

**Timetable for the Course (approx)**

- 08.15 Arrive, sign on, tea, coffee & biscuits
- 09.00 Introduction, safety procedures, classroom instruction
- 09.45 Split into small groups, course walked with instructor
- 10.45 Instructor accompanied run followed by individual runs
- 12.30 Lunch, video and verbal assessment
- 13.45 Afternoon runs followed by final instructor accompanied run
- 15.45 Last car on the hill
- 16.00 Final assessment, presentation of certificates plus an award for the highest points
